## Perfectly Put Together

DESIRING THE PERFECT gathering space for sharing in preparation, cooking, and indulging, these Virginia homeowners hired Stacey L. Hoffman of Great Falls Construction/Riverbend Custom Cabinetry & Millwork. And with a focus on form and function, Hoffman designed this new custom kitchen to blend the demands of everyday living and entertaining.

Her main challenge was to design an island that could accommodate a large work surface and serve as an eat-in space for four—all while not overwhelming the rest of the kitchen. The result: A two-tiered perpendicular island that serves as the central command center, providing a large prep area with a pullout cutting board and sink as support stations.

Across from this prep station, the range with interchangeable griddle and grill can handle any order. All accoutrements are readily available from twin pullout spice racks flanking the cooking surfaces and from drawers below for spoons, spatulas, and the like. Other interesting cabinet storage features include rollout drawers, a large corner super Lazy Susan, custom panels over appliances, and a double-bin pullout for trash and recycling—all of which are equipped with soft-close concealed hinges.
